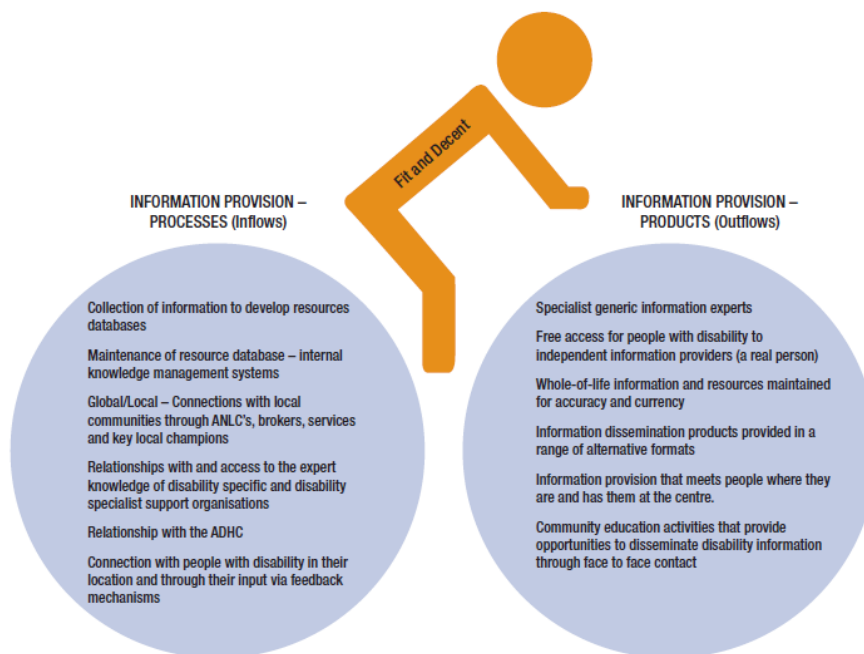
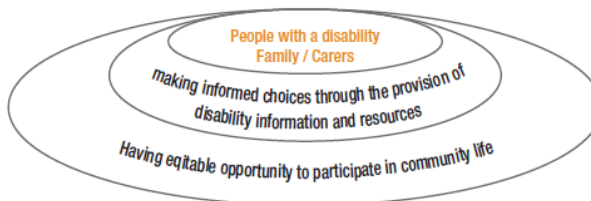
We provide information that assists people with disability make informed decisions about matters of importance to them.

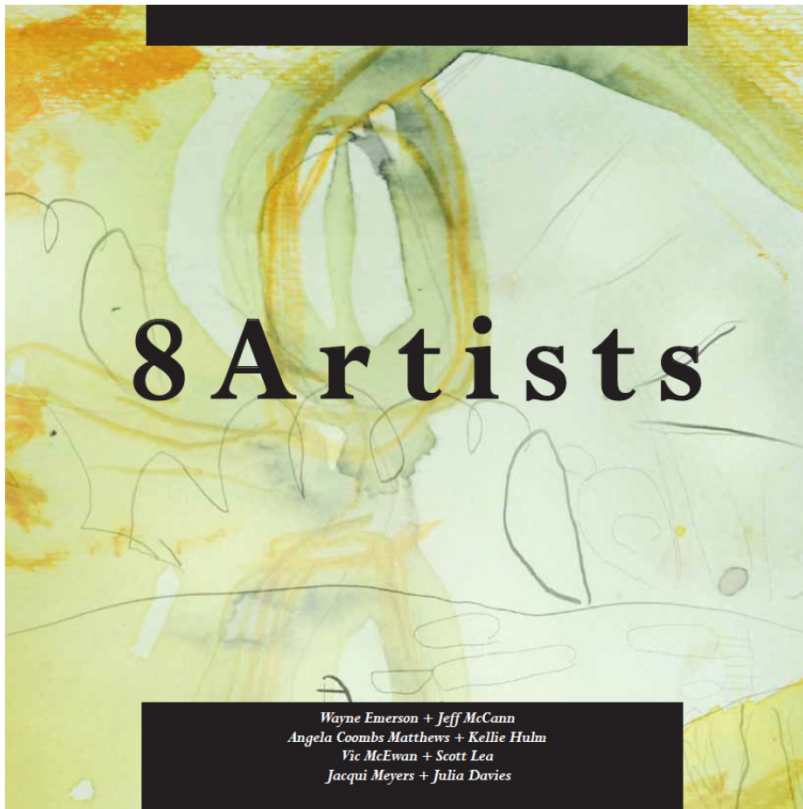
